SCHEDULE AND PAIRINGS

The low 16-20 scores Saturday in the Amateur Division will be paired together in "LEADER GROUPS" on Sunday in the final foursomes of the day. Professionals will be paired with other Professionals both days.

Otherwise, for **ALL OTHER PLAYERS**, pairings will **REMAIN THE SAME** for both Saturday and Sunday. Contestants desiring to be paired together should list their group in the space provided on the front page of this entry blank. Any contestants not listing specific playing partners will be paired together at the discretion of tournament staff.

COMPETITION WILL BE OVER 36 HOLES

First Day, Saturday — 18 Holes Medal Play
Second Day, Sunday — 18 Holes Medal Play

Lowest Scores for 36 holes from the Blue Tees will be declared champion in the Amateur and Professional Divisions. Ties for first place will be determined in hole-by-hole play-off immediately following play on Sunday. In case of partial rain-out, one day score will determine championship. If rain intensifies, 9 holes may determine championship. If rain cancels the tournament, it will be rescheduled.

In order to be eligible to be declared the overall tournament winner in the Amateur Division, the player must play from the Blue Tees. Older players (65 and over) in the Amateur Division will be allowed to compete from the Yellow Tees.

RULES OF GOLF

Play will be governed by the rules of golf as approved by USGA, and a local Rules Sheet applicable to the tournament will be provided on Saturday. Questions shall be settled by the Tournament Rules Committee, whose decision shall be final.

Use of ARTIFICIAL DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES WILL BE PERMITTED (DISTANCE ONLY). A limited number of tournament carts will have such devices permanently mounted on them. Paxton Park DOES NOT GUARANTEE, NOR RESERVE, ANY CARTS WITH SUCH DEVICES, NOR THEIR ACCURACY. It is strongly recommended that players desiring to use such devices bring their own.

Score cards must be checked before signing. Contestants are responsible for individual hole scores.

PRACTICE PRIVILEGES

One free practice round privilege is extended to paid-up players during the Monday through Friday immediately preceding the tournament. Carts can be rented during practice rounds.

PERSONAL GOLF CARTS

Contestants are permitted to bring their own cart to the tournament. There is no additional charge during the tournament, as the entry fee includes cart rental and trail fees for the two days of the tournament. A \$18.00 trail fee will be charged, however, for use of private carts during practice rounds.

ENTRY FEE REFUNDS

Entry fee will be returned in full if the Tournament Director receives notice of cancellation by 6:00 PM MONDAY, September 4, 2017.

IMPORTANT: No entries will be accepted without a paid entry fee. (Telephone entries will not be accepted.) Faxed entries (270-442-2116) must include credit card information.

AMATEUR FLIGHTS, AWARDS & TEES PLAYED

AGE GROUP 50-54 — 2 to 4 flights to be divided equally, subsequent to completion of the tournament. First 3 places awarded in each flight. Players will play from Blue Tees.

AGE GROUP 55-59 — Same as above.

AGE GROUP 60-64 — Same as above.

AGE GROUP 65-69 — Same as above, except players will play from Yellow Tees.

AGE GROUP 70-74 — Same as above, except players will play from Yellow Tees.

AGE GROUP 75-79 — Same as above, except players will play from Yellow Tees.

AGE GROUP 80-OVER — 1 flight. First 3 places awarded. Players will play from Red Tees.

PROFESSIONAL PURSE

Professional prize money will consist of entry fee pool from Professional entry fees, less tournament favors, plus \$150 added prize money. All Professionals will play from Blue Tees.
